

Programme

On the first day we arrive in the afternoon in Holland in Wijchen, about 15 km from the border with Germany. Here we can unhook the trailers at the property of the Hans & Lucia Boode family. The trailers can stay there until the last day.

From there we go with our MGs to the hotel 'de Witte Bergen', about 35 km east of



Amsterdam. We stayed in this hotel for 3 nights and from here we discovered the east of the Netherlands.

On the evening of the first day we have dinner together in the hotel.

On the second day, after breakfast at the hotel, we will take a ride along a famous and beautiful river called “Vecht”. The Vecht is a small river, but one that has been important in history. Already in the times ancient Romans gave the name Fectio to this river. In the medieval period the Vecht was important because it connected the inland sea of the Netherlands and the Rhine.

For this reason some castles such as Muiderslot at the end of the river are located there. Because the area through which the river flows is so beautiful, many stately homes were built in the 17th century to serve as second homes for wealthy Amsterdam merchants.

After the visit we return to the hotel for dinner.



On the third day we will drive from the hotel to a famous city called Gouda, known for cheese production. There we will participate in a Dutch cheese experience, after which we will visit the town hall.

After Gouda we will go with our cars to Kinderdijk, where you can see the famous



Dutch mills. During the trip we will stop for lunch and also make a stop for a boat ride.

From there we will take you to Teun and Wilma's property and dinner will be served on the island by your Dutch MG friends. In the evening we return to the hotel.

On the fourth day we will return to the east of Holland again. During the trip we will have lunch and then visit a famous classic car gallery called "Aaldering".



After the visit we will arrive at the hotel in Berg & Dal.



On the last day we will have a morning trip and visit with lunch to the Open Lucht Museum in Arnhem. In this 44-hectare open-air museum you will find houses, factories, trams, mills and gardens from all over the Netherlands.



After the visit we will return to the hotel crossing the protected nature reserves. Dinner in the hotel.

On the morning of the sixth day we return to Hans Boode to reconnect the trailers and return to Italy.
